

OTHER NEWS ... For the water plant, additional filtration will be installed early this summer that will allow us to increase our water production by 100,000 gallons per day for peak season use; For the Transfer Station, two gas generators have been converted to propane and the third will be converted before the end of the month; For the S-W Cemetery, NorthCoast did the spring cleanup and we purchased a small John Deere Tractor with a 42" deck that allows easier access between grave sites for cutting/mulching.
